**1892** Dr. S. Irving Strayer opens Strayer's Business College in Baltimore, Md.

The school helps adults acquire relevant business skills to enter and succeed in a rapidly expanding post-Industrial job market.



**1904** The school's popularity leads to a second location in Washington, D.C.

Dr. Strayer opens a campus at the corner of 9th and F Streets, N.W. The campus eventually became the cornerstone of Strayer University and started with just two teachers on staff.

**1913** As the accounting field grows, Strayer helps students take advantage of new opportunities.

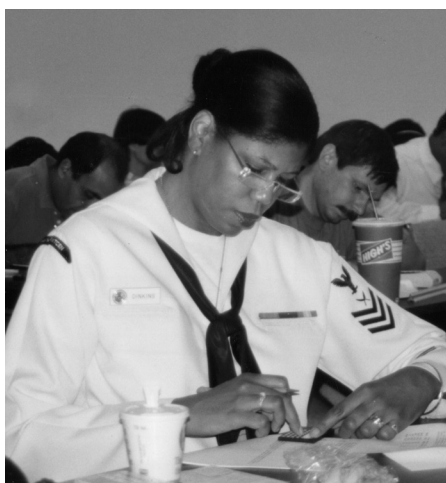
The passage of Federal income tax laws and the post-war boom leads Strayer to establish its College of Accountancy, graduating qualified professionals to work in the field.

**1920** Women win the right to vote.

Strayer – which had been educating women since its founding – prepares them for roles as clerks, librarians and secretaries.

**1945** The G.I. bill is established, providing higher education benefits to veterans.

To this day, Strayer proudly services veterans and active duty members of the U.S. military, providing support and flexibility that service members need to achieve their goals.



**1969** Technology proliferates, and Strayer expands. The appetite for higher education grows as technology takes off. Strayer adds new offerings and is licensed to grant the Bachelor of Science degree, becoming Strayer College.



## 1996 Strayer launches a groundbreaking online learning program.

The dot com boom drastically changes the business landscape. Strayer is among the first accredited, higher-learning institutions to offer courses via the Internet. Two years later, Strayer College is granted university status and becomes Strayer University.

## 2012 Strayer partners with business legend Jack Welch to offer an executive MBA program.

The Jack Welch Management Institute is home to a Top 25 Princeton Review-ranked executive MBA program, infused with the expertise of Jack Welch.

## 2016 Story-driven content emerges as a business trend with staying power.

Strayer Studios, an in-house creative team, develops immersive, compelling films around business fundamentals and course content. The films deepen students' engagement with their coursework and improve learning outcomes.

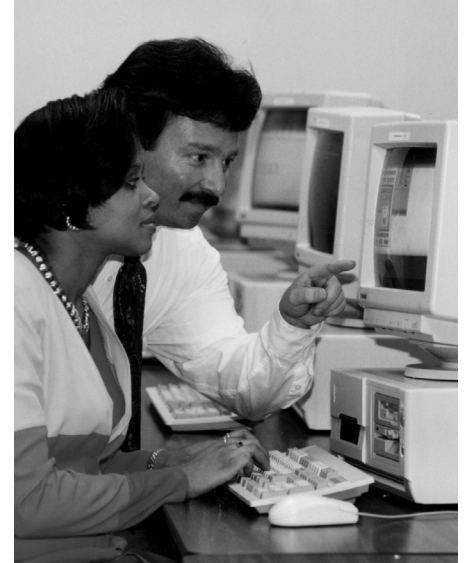
## 2018 Strayer opens its first café-style hybrid campus in Macon, Ga.

## Shantae L. Joseph

Shantae Joseph began her career in the Air Force at age 18. She served nearly 6 years, and after leaving the military she wanted a career focused on helping others achieve a better quality of life. Shantae landed a job as a regional manager for a temporary staffing company and built on that experience to start a successful human resources consulting business.

However, when she wanted to take her career to the next level in corporate leadership roles, her lack of a college degree held her back.

It was time to go back to school. Even with three children under age 9, she was determined to move forward. She explored her local community college, but it wasn't the right learning environment for a busy adult like her.

Strayer University provided the flexibility she needed, and it was a better fit: "I walked in there and told them my story," she says. "They said, 'You've got to start somewhere.'"

Shantae sped through her associate degree, but her bachelor's program was more challenging. "I would help my kids finish their homework, and then it was my turn," she says. "Tons of late nights."

Things got harder with her mother's cancer diagnosis. She kept up while being a caregiver and even found the strength to continue when her mother passed away. Her perseverance and faith allowed her to earn her master's degree.

Today, Shantae is a senior vice president, external engagements, and national constituents' relationship manager at Wells Fargo. She leads national partnerships to support scholarship, skills-based hiring, mentoring, and leadership development programs for diverse students. "This job allows me to make an impact within the community and truly help change generational wealth," she says. "My purpose has now intersected with my passion."

So, how did Shantae's Strayer experience change her life? "It validated my experience, established my confidence, and gave me a seat at the table," she says.



## Jennifer Marie Hall

Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice Candidate



Jennifer Hall admits that she was not the best student in high school. She continued to college anyway, but it didn't last long. "My heart just wasn't in it," she says. "I didn't have my 'why' yet."

She found her 'why' when her son was born. Being a mom spurred her ambitions. Previously, as a military spouse who moved around a lot, Jennifer had taken a string of retail and customer-service jobs to make ends meet. But now she wanted more — for herself and her family. "I wanted a degree, and I wanted a career," she says.

She found her way forward thanks to some inspiration from her family. Her mother enrolled at Strayer University, and Jennifer visited a campus out of curiosity. When she saw they had a program in criminal justice — a subject she'd been passionate about since middle school — she signed up on the spot. "I think I startled the staff member who worked there," she says. "I was just so excited."

She loved being back in school, but she faced challenges. Jennifer gave birth to her second child and had to manage a newborn, a toddler, and a demanding course load. Later, she contracted COVID-19, which led to pneumonia. But she always found support from her professors, and she never missed a beat. Today she is graduating with a 4.0 GPA.

And she's not done yet. Soon she'll start a master's program in mental health, which will help her prepare for two important goals. One, to become a forensic psychologist. And two, to provide counseling for disabled veterans.

"After Strayer, I feel so accomplished," Jennifer says. "I know where I'm going. I see the stepping stones. I have the drive and the want-to. There's very little that's going to stop me."
