**1892** Dr. S. Irving Strayer opens Strayer's Business College in Baltimore, Md.

The school helps adults acquire relevant business skills to enter and succeed in a rapidly expanding post-Industrial job market.



**1904** The school's popularity leads to a second location in Washington, D.C.

Dr. Strayer opens a campus at the corner of 9th and F Streets, N.W. The campus eventually became the cornerstone of Strayer University and started with just two teachers on staff.

**1913** As the accounting field grows, Strayer helps students take advantage of new opportunities.

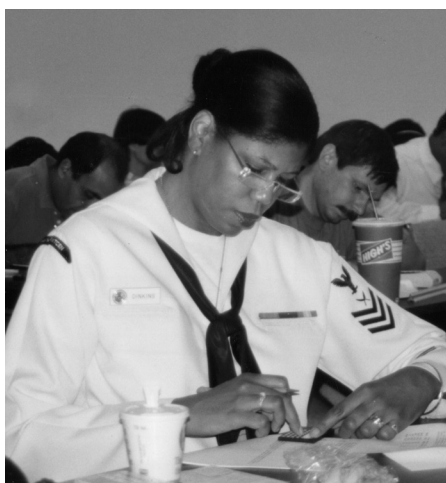
The passage of Federal income tax laws and the post-war boom leads Strayer to establish its College of Accountancy, graduating qualified professionals to work in the field.

**1920** Women win the right to vote.

Strayer – which had been educating women since its founding – prepares them for roles as clerks, librarians and secretaries.

**1945** The G.I. bill is established, providing higher education benefits to veterans.

To this day, Strayer proudly services veterans and active duty members of the U.S. military, providing support and flexibility that service members need to achieve their goals.



**1969** Technology proliferates, and Strayer expands. The appetite for higher education grows as technology takes off. Strayer adds new offerings and is licensed to grant the Bachelor of Science degree, becoming Strayer College.



## 1996 Strayer launches a groundbreaking online learning program.

The dot com boom drastically changes the business landscape. Strayer is among the first accredited, higher-learning institutions to offer courses via the Internet. Two years later, Strayer College is granted university status and becomes Strayer University.

## 2012 Strayer partners with business legend Jack Welch to offer an executive MBA program.

The Jack Welch Management Institute is home to a Top 25 Princeton Review-ranked executive MBA program, infused with the expertise of Jack Welch.

## 2016 Story-driven content emerges as a business trend with staying power.

Strayer Studios, an in-house creative team, develops immersive, compelling films around business fundamentals and course content. The films deepen students' engagement with their coursework and improve learning outcomes.

## 2018 Strayer opens its first café-style hybrid campus in Macon, Ga.

The new campus style allows students the in-person support they need while also providing select classes, academic advising, and a place for students to network and unwind. Finding success with this approach, Strayer has since opened additional café-style campuses across the country.

## Jackson Parker

Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, 2013



Jackson Parker's parents left Afghanistan during the Soviet occupation and built a new life in the U.S. Their experience made a big impact on him. "My parents fleeing a war-torn country motivated me to be the best person I can be," Parker says. "I've always been interested in public service."

After high school, he enlisted in the Army. When he returned from his second deployment in Iraq, Jackson considered his future. "I was at the crossroads between continuing my military service and trying something else," he said.

His desire to serve led him toward law enforcement, and he began a criminal justice program at Strayer while still on active duty. "After my first semester, I decided this was for me," he says.

One week after graduating, Jackson joined a police force in Northern Virginia, where he excelled as a field training officer, crisis intervention officer, and police negotiator.

He has since taken his career to the next level. Today Jackson is a special agent in Washington, D.C., working at the highest levels of government to investigate domestic threats and counterintelligence issues. "Every case that lands on my desk impacts national security," he says.

Jackson credits his Strayer education for helping him get where he is today. "Without going to Strayer, I would never have been the police officer that I was. I doubt I would have gotten my current job either." Because of that, he wants to help others succeed. Jackson is a volunteer ambassador for Strayer's criminal justice program, and he has helped hundreds of students to advance their studies. "The circle always comes back in full," he says.

One day, that circle may bring him back to Strayer again: "I'm eligible for retirement in my early 40s," he says. "I've thought about becoming an adjunct professor at Strayer."



## Melanie Irwin-Dugdale

Bachelor of Business Administration Candidate



**A**fter high school, Melanie Dugdale never wanted to set foot in a classroom again. “I was a terrible student. I was so glad to get out of high school, and I never looked back,” she says. But years later, her tune changed — when her children were thinking about college.

“I couldn’t ask my kids to do something that I hadn’t done myself,” Melanie explains. “When I came across Strayer, I realized I could work and go to school and get my degree.”

From her first day at Strayer, Melanie noticed a change in herself. “I think a lot of it is confidence,” she says. “Strayer has helped me to problem solve, to manage my time — I’ve loved every single minute of it.”

She also noticed a change at work. As a program manager for a federal contractor, she’s seen her responsibilities grow to include new projects for additional government agencies. Today she manages teams and budgets for projects from Baghdad to Japan. “I’m able to use a lot of the things that I have learned at Strayer, and I can implement them, and it works,” she says.

But maybe the most satisfying change was in her kids. Her son, who had put off college for several years, finally decided to take the plunge, saying “If mom can do it, I can do it.”

Next up for Melanie is an MBA, also at Strayer. And after that, “the sky’s the limit,” she says. “I could see myself moving into senior leadership.”

So, what does Melanie tell others who are thinking about school? “Do it. Just do it,” she says. “If you don’t continue your academic journey straight out of high school, you can go back no matter how old you are. It is the best thing you can do for yourself.”



## KEYNOTE SPEAKER

### Brian W. Jones, J. D.

President Emeritus, Strayer University



**B**rian W. Jones is President Emeritus of Strayer University. Mr. Jones joined Strayer University in 2012 as its General Counsel. In 2014, he became a founding team member of Strayer@Work, an entrepreneurial venture of Strayer's parent company, conceived to provide workplace solutions to corporate clients. In June 2015, Mr. Jones was named the 16th president of Strayer University.

Prior to joining Strayer, Mr. Jones co-founded Latimer Education, a venture-backed startup devoted to partnering with an Historically Black College or University (HBCU), to assist the HBCU in offering its academic programs online.

Jones also served as a higher education lawyer in private practice, representing institutions, investors, entrepreneurs, and education lenders.

In 2001, Mr. Jones was nominated by the President of the United States, and unanimously confirmed by the U. S. Senate, to serve as General Counsel of the U.S. Department of Education, the agency's chief legal advisor to the Secretary and to each of the agency's offices. He served in that role from 2001-2005.

In addition to his professional commitments, Mr. Jones has served on an array of corporate, educational and philanthropic boards. He currently serves on the board of College Loan Corporation, a privately held student loan servicer, on whose board he has sat since 2010. He previously chaired the boards of the National Alliance for Public Charter Schools, the leading national advocacy organization for the nation's public charter schools and its stakeholders, and the DC Public Charter School Board (PCSB), the sole authorizing and oversight body of public charter schools in the nation's capital. He was appointed to the PCSB by DC Mayor Adrian Fenty and reappointed by Mayor Vincent Grey.

In addition to chairing those two boards, Mr. Jones also served on the boards of DC Prep Public Charter Schools; Monument Academy Public Charter School; Charter Board Partners; St. Andrews Episcopal School Center for Transformative Teaching & Learning (CTTL); and The Washington Ballet.

Mr. Jones earned his undergraduate degree, a BSBA in Finance, from Georgetown University, and his law degree, a JD, from the UCLA School of Law.
